## Minutes of the Meeting:

#### 1. Welcome Address:

The Chairperson welcomed the members and commended the efforts taken since the previous meeting toward academic improvement and administrative reforms.

#### 2. Review of Action Taken:

- Workshops on teaching innovations were successfully conducted for faculty in January 2025.
- The 360-degree feedback mechanism has been initiated for second-year BAMS students and staff.
- Health camps were organized in December 2024 and February 2025 in nearby rural areas.

#### 3. Evaluation of Benchmarks:

- Student satisfaction levels (via feedback) showed a 20% increase in clinical training satisfaction.
- Administrative digitization (OPD records and leave management) is
   70% complete.
- Initial clinical audit reports show enhanced patient flow and better documentation.
